SOUTHEASTRANS RECEIVES 2010 PACESETTER AWARD

April 23, 2010, Atlanta, GA – For the second consecutive year, Southeastrans, Inc. received a Pacesetter award from the *Atlanta Business Chronicle* as one of the fastest growing companies in the Atlanta area. The weekly business publication surveyed private companies in the 20-county metro Atlanta area to find the top 50 companies with the fastest growth between 2007 and 2009. Southeastrans ranked 25th in growth based on a weighted average growth index score used to even the field among companies of different sizes. Only companies with annual revenues between \$1 million and \$300 million were considered in the ranking. During the three year period surveyed, Southeastrans' annual revenues increased from \$40.3 million to \$80.7 million, a 100.2% increase over the three year term.

Southeastrans began managing Medicaid non-emergency medical transportation programs in two metro Atlanta counties in 2000. Currently the company operates in 82 Georgia counties under three contracts with the Georgia Department of Community Health. In 2008, Southeastrans contracted with Volunteer State Health Plan, a wholly-owned subsidiary of BlueCross/BlueShield of Tennessee, to manage the statewide transportation needs of TennCare members enrolled through the managed-care company's BlueCare and TennCare*Select* programs. Southeastrans coordinates non-emergency medical transportation services for 1.3 million Medicaid members in Georgia and Tennessee and provides over 2.6 million trips annually.
